Fully describe the business's activities?

This franchise offers an authentic South African fast food experience, and with its unique concept and distinctive brand, is growing steadily. This opportunity includes a complete turnkey operation, training and full franchisor support with great ROI capabilities.

How does the business operate on a daily basis?

Food is freshly prepared daily, and while the store can be manager run, owners are required to oversee operations closely to ensure that processes and procedures are followed, and that the franchisor's standards of quality and service are maintained. Full training for both franchisees and staff will be provided.

What Advertising/Marketing is carried out?

The group has a very nice website, and extensive social media marketing for the group as well as each franchise store is carried out by the franchisor themselves through their marketing arm. Their target market has been clearly defined and they have adopted a marketing strategy to match. They have a vast database of clients and also drive the brand through regular WhatsApp campaigns.

What competition exists?

There are a number of similar fast food franchises, however, this concept is quite different and is uniquely positioned around favourite South African foods.

What are the main assets of the business?
